#### VI. FEES:

The fee structure for all the institutions shall be as per policy of respective Governments. The latest fee structure, if any, for Punjab as well as Chandigarh will be notified through web sites at the time of admissions.

The security amount deposited by the candidates shall be refunded to them on successful completion of Diploma course by the concerned institution.

#### VII. REFUND OF FEES:

In the event of a student/candidate surrendering the seat before starting of the course, the admission fee collected from the student after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- shall be refunded. However if a student leaves after joining the course and the seat consequently falls vacant is filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the fee shall be refunded after making proportionate deductions of fee and hostel rent (where applicable).

The Candidates who have successfully passed the qualifying examination shall be eligible to apply for admission to various courses mentioned in the prospectus. All candidates desirous of admission to diploma courses shall be required to register their details on the counselling website (www.psbte.gov.in) to participate in the online counselling.

#### I. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- 1. The admission to diploma level courses shall be made on the basis of the merit of the subjects Maths, Science and English with overall status pass in the matriculation examination.
- The admission to First year of the four year Part Time Diploma Courses shall be made on the basis of
  relative merit of total marks obtained in Mathematics, Science and English subjects with overall pass in
  matriculation examination; and the candidate should be in employment at the time of admission with two
  years of work experience in a registered firm/company/industry on full time basis.

- 4. There is no lower or upper age limit for admission.

The Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Chandigarh (hereinafter the Board) as the authority competent to conduct the online counselling on the basis of merit of qualifying examination for admissions to 1st Year of various Three Year Diploma Level Engineering Courses being run in all the Polytechnics/ Institutions located in the State of Punjab for the session 2021-22, which are affiliated with the Board and stand approved by the All India Council for Technical Education for the session 2021-22 as per the prescribed intake.

The Board shall make admissions, subject to affiliation granted by it to these institutions,

# A ) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA LEVEL ENGINEERING COURSES

The admission to the Diploma level Engineering Courses shall be through online counselling. Student should be passed 10<sup>th</sup> standard/SSC examination and should have obtained at least 35% marks in qualifying examination as prescribed by All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi in the approval process handbook 2021-22.

II For the Academic session 2021-22, 85% seats shall be reserved for the internal candidates from within the State of Punjab and 15% shall be open to all candidates from outside Punjab, on all India basis.

III The Eligibility criteria for 85% seats shall be for candidates who are resident of Punjab State as per Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3PPII/9619 dated 6<sup>th</sup> June 1996 and letter No. 1/3/95-3PPII /80 dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1999 or shall have passed the matriculation examination from an institution/school affiliated to Punjab School Education Board/ CBSE/ ICSE/ National Open School situated in Punjab. The candidate would be required to submit a domicile certificate to this effect from the Principal/Head of Institution last attended in the prescribed Performa as given in the prospectus.

IV. Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the

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general eligibility criteria shall be as mentioned in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003.

V. The Punjab State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training,
Punjab shall follow a proper process for making such admissions.

VI Admission of candidates, who fulfill all eligibility conditions, shall be made on the basis of the relative merit subject to reservation of scats, the detailed instructions in respect of which are given in Section B.

VII. The students shall pay the fees/ development fee and other charges both for the various seats, as per rates fixed by the Government of Punjab/Union Territory of Chandigarh or the Board.

VIII. The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/Person of Indian origin shall be the same as for NRI candidates.

IX. The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per Punjab Government in this regard. (Memo No. 8/21/11-ITE2/501423/1 dated 05.06.2015)

X. The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian Origin shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-ITE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2003.

XI. The guidelines for admission of Sikh minority community students to Guru Nanak Dev Polytechnic College, Ludhiana and Baba Banda Singh Bahadur Polytechnic College, Fatehgarh Sahib shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 18/33/2001-GC (6) 4513 dated Chandigarh, the 3rd April, 2001.

XII. The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt. Departments of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2008, no.13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 dated 20<sup>th</sup> June 2008 and No.13/129/03-1TE2/171 dt.17<sup>th</sup> January 2011 as amended from time to time.

XIII. There shall be no bifurcation of the seats into "free seats" and "paid seats" This is in compliance with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its judgment the case of T.M.A. Pai Foundation and other vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) (8 SCC 481: AIR 2004 SC 355), and the instructions of Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development and the AICTE.

XIV. Academic session for newly admitted students may commence as per

the academic schedule of All India Council for Technical Education, New Dolhi for academic year 2021-22.

XV. State Government reserves its right to change any condition at any point of time.

# B) RESERVATION:

- I. The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013 and Memo No. 8/41/2019-4TE2/53 dated 13<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2019. As regards the reservation of seats of Polytechnics under Union Territory, Chandigarh, the same shall be as per the policy intimated by the Chandigarh Administration to the Board.
- II. The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been issued on or before the last date of counselling shall only be accepted. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the cut-off date, otherwise their certificates shall not be considered and their claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. No extension shall be granted in this regard, under any circumstances. This provision should be given wide publicity and also included conspicuously in the prospectus—cum-information brochure to be issued by the Board.
- III. The Board shall make a provision in the Online Admission application form for the candidates to indicate the category, if any, under which they are seeking reservation. In case of no reservation is claimed in the application form, candidate shall be treated as general category. The Government of Punjab may also set up a Committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013. In the absence of this Committee, the Board shall effect this inter se gradation, in accordance with the criteria laid down in the aforesaid memo dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013.
- IV. A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation under one reserved category only. However, the procedure for counselling/ allotment of courses and/ or institutes shall be such that if a candidate is getting a course/ institution higher in his/ her order of preference, as a general candidate, he/ she shall be so regarded, notwithstanding his/ her claim as a reserved category candidate. The seat under the reserved category shall then be offered to the

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candidates in that very reserved category.

V. The unfilled seat in any reserved category shall be merged in the General Category quota after all eligible candidates of the reserved categories have been called for counselling.

# ONLINE- COUNSELLING

- I. For admission to various Diploma Courses web based online counselling shall be followed for the Academic year 2021-22 and therefore physical presence of candidates for the counselling will not be necessary.
- II. During the online counselling, candidate shall be given opportunity to exercise choice of institutes / trade in centralized counselling and thereafter the vacant seats, if any, shall be filled by the institute on the criteria of admissions under vacant seats/management quota. It is categorically laid down that vacant seats are not being transferred as management quota seats. Only criteria as laid down for admission under management quota should remain applicable to fill such vacant seats.

- IV. While fixing the date of counselling for admissions, the Board shall keep in view the cutoff date and schedule for approval by All India Council for Technical Education for the academic session 2021-22.
- v. There shall be two rounds of centralized counselling by State Board of Technical Education, Punjab Chandigarh. The schedule and Deadline of counseling will be as per Academic Calendar issued by AICTE in June, 2021 for the academic session 2021-22 and strictly as per orders of honorable Supreme Court.
